Construction-related erosion can cause problems for downgradient property owners, clog storm drains, create flooding problems on adjacent streets, and lead to the sedimentation and silting of streams, reservoirs and other water bodies.

Uncontrolled erosion is costly, violates state and federal pollution laws, and exposes those with oversight authority (landowners, developers, contractors, municipalities and consultants) to legal liability.

Fortunately, during construction most erosion and sediment problems can be prevented or greatly reduced through proper planning and implementation of simple and low-cost effective control practices.

Further, incorporating stormwater treatment measures in new and redevelopment projects will minimize pollutant discharges for the life of the project.

Workshop attendees will acquire an understanding of how to comply with the general permit requirements; simple and effective BMP tools for projects; information on monitoring, documentation, site plan updates, sampling and management approaches to stay in compliance; and post construction/stormwater management techniques.
